A maximum of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope for entries. Hand deliveries within the first 24 hours of trial opening are not allowed.

Entries Close, Wednesday, August 18, 2009 at 12:00 Noon - WCOTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 15 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to August 18, 2010 at 12:00 Noon. Any entries withdrawn that are received by August 30, 2010 at Noon will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by August 30, 2010 at Noon will receive a full refund. A reason for the withdrawal of a dog is required.

Site Information

The Pittsburgh Indoor Sports Arena (PISA) is air conditioned. All doors must be left closed. Except for the main entrance, all exits are for emergencies only. If PSIA personnel find any doors left open, the air conditioners will be turned off.

- Crates may be left overnight at owners' discretion. No dogs may be left overnight. A tarp, mat or plastic must be placed under crates, x-pens, chairs, and food/water bowls.
- Please clean-up after your dogs. Clean-up supplies will be available.
- Food and beverages will be available for purchase on the show site. Food and beverages may not be brought into the field area of the arena.

- ❑ Entries received without fees or correct fees will be returned to sender. Credit cards cannot be accepted. Make fees payable in US FUNDS. Trial secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- ❑ Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- ❑ Exhibitors will pay all bank charges for bounced checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- ❑ No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made
- ❑ A dog withdrawn from the trial after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge will receive a full refund.
- ❑ Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- ❑ Express mail entries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Show Secretary's address. Mail requiring signatures will be returned to sender. Faxed or e-mailed entries cannot be accepted. No online entries will be taken for this trial.
- ❑ Entries must be on the Official AKC Agility Entry Form for Agility Trial AEAGL2 - (01/10)OLAV5P. Entry forms without the AKC agreement, attached to the entry form, are NOT ACCEPTABLE and will be returned to the exhibitor. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable and dog cannot be entered in the trial. (AKC Rule Ch 14, Sec 4)
- ❑ Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- ❑ Entry form changes, additions or corrections must be received in writing prior to the August 18, 2010 closing date.
- ❑ If you provide a valid, legible, unblocked email address, your entries will be acknowledged via email when received. To receive a confirmation by US mail, Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Final confirmation and judging program will also be sent via email after the trial closes. If you do not provide an email address, your conformation letter and judging program will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. If you have not received your confirmation five days before the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may compete, but they must be measured by the Judge of Record prior to running in their class. This measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24", 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid height card must be measured prior to running. This does not preclude having the dog measured by the Judge of Record if the VMO or the Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial(s).

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

- ❑ This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.
- ❑ Dogs with Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.
- ❑ Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is bandaged or taped in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
- ❑ Bitches in season are not eligible to compete. Bitches in season are eligible for a full refund with veterinarian confirmation. The Trial Secretary must be notified by noon, September 6, 2010. Refunds will be mailed.

Move-Ups

- ❑ If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be moved up to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 PM, Monday, August 30, 2010. Move-ups can be mailed to the Trial Secretary or emailed to poodles4me@verizon.net. No verbal move-ups will be accepted.
- ❑ Move-ups will be accommodated from Saturday to Sunday to Monday.

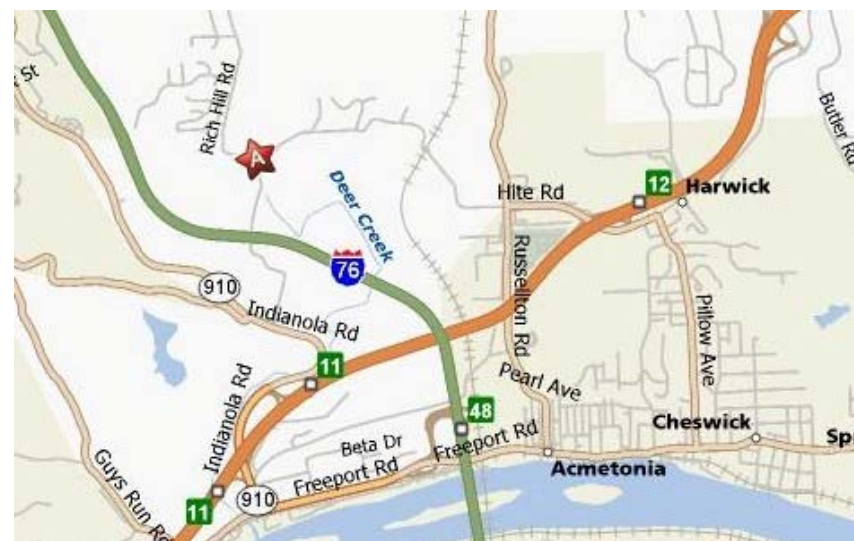
Notice to Exhibitors

- ❑ *Declination of Entries.* Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against WCOTC, or any official thereof.
- ❑ *No entry fee will be refunded* if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ❑ *Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate* when it is their turn to run. Failure to be at the ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.
- ❑ *All Dogs* present at the site must be on leads or confined to crates or x-pens when not being judged, except when in the exercise area or designated warm-up area. No exceptions. A designated exercise area is provided.
- ❑ *Puppies under the age of six months* are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.
- ❑ *Exhibitors alone are responsible* for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- ❑ *The safety of the dog is our primary concern.* By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ❑ *A limited amount of Catalogs* will be available at the trials at \$5.00 per catalog. For a prepaid catalog, check appropriate block on entry form.
- ❑ *WCOTC will not be responsible* for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Directions

From Pittsburgh and South: Take Route 28 North to the Harmar exit. Turn LEFT onto PA -910 and proceed for approximately 1/4 mile until you almost reach the crest of the hill. Turn RIGHT onto RICH HILL RD. Proceed to the arena on the right.

From East/West via Pennsylvania Turnpike: Take exit 48 (Harmar). Follow sign to Pittsburgh. Merge onto FREEPORT RD. (PA business route 28). Travel approximately 1/2 mile. Turn LEFT onto PA-910 and proceed for approximately 1/4 mile until you almost reach the crest of the hill. Turn RIGHT onto RICH HILL RD. Proceed to the arena on the right.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
